A SEVENTH ship will be joining the Disney Cruise Line! Get ready to welcome the **Disney Adventure** – which will set sail on her maiden voyage out of Singapore on **March 10, 2026!**

Announced in November 2022, the Disney Adventure will be the first Disney Cruise Line ship to **sail from Singapore and throughout Southeast Asia**, offering 3- and 4-night voyages for future passengers.

The Disney Adventure will feature several **Disney, Pixar, and Marvel stories** on a ship that Disney says will be their “biggest adventure yet.”

The Adventure will feature **seven themed and immersive areas**, and some of those areas will feature experiences never before seen on a Disney Cruise ship!

# NEW LOCATIONS



The hub of the Disney Adventure will be called **Disney Imagination Garden**. This is an “enchanted valley” inspired by more than 100 years' worth of Disney storytelling. Here, you'll find all kinds of Easter eggs, restaurants, a courtyard, a topiary of Sorcerer Mickey, and even Disney's first castle at sea with artwork that spans 3 decks tall. Plus, this area will have an open-air Garden Stage (with stairs that create amphitheater-style seating) with live shows throughout the day.



**Disney Discovery Reef** is an open-air area that will house dining and shopping offerings. The space is themed to the “nautical worlds” of *The Little Mermaid*, *Lilo & Stitch*, *Finding Nemo*, and *Luca*. Be sure to check it out at night when it transforms into a “bioluminescent paradise.”

**Town Square** will be a “fantastical forest” where passengers can find shops, lounges, cafes, restaurants, and entertainment venues. The area will draw inspiration from tales such as *Tangled*, *Cinderella*, *Frozen*, and more.

## NEW LOCATIONS *Continued*




**Toy Story Place** will be on the ship's upper decks and will be a *Toy Story*-inspired area with a family pool, whirlpool spas, slides, splash pads, dining options, outdoor movies, trivia, and more!

If you're looking for a place to relax, visit **Wayfinder Bay**. Here, you'll find a pool area with tiered deck seating, the Wayfinder Bar, a wading pool, and a massive screen. The pool area here will also function as a spot for interactive events and live shows, including "Moana: Call of the Sea."



**San Fransokyo Street** is another of the 7 themed areas. This space, inspired by *Big Hero 6*, is where you and your family will find lots of entertainment, including tween and teen youth clubs (that are disguised as shops), a gaming lounge, interactive activities, shops, cinemas, and more. You'll find a "trolley stop and cable car lounge area" and a street stand cafe too. Plus, you'll get to meet Baymax here!

# MARVEL LANDING



Another of the 7 themed locations on this ship is “**Marvel Landing!**” Located on one of the upper decks, this is where you’ll be able to meet your favorite Marvel heroes and experience different attractions at sea.

This area will have **three different rides:** Groot Galaxy Spin, Pym Quantum Racers, and Ironcycle Test Run.

**Ironcycle Test Run** will be the **first-ever roller coaster aboard a Disney Cruise Line ship,** and the longest coaster at sea at over 820 feet in length! The ride will be suspended up to 30 feet above the upper deck of the ship and will allow riders to test drive Tony Stark’s Ironcycle prototype.

**Pym Quantum Racers** is a speedy go-kart attraction inspired by Ant-Man and The Wasp and their use of Pym Particles.

**Groot Galaxy Spin** is a family-friendly spinning ride that hoists riders in the air while fueled by the music from the Guardians of the Galaxy films.

Plus, in this area, you can check out the **Infinity Pool & Bar.**



# RESTAURANTS OVERVIEW

The Disney Adventure will offer Disney Cruise Line's signature rotational dining. This means you'll have three distinct dining experiences on your vacation.

One of the rotational restaurants is the **Hollywood Spotlight Club**. Here, you'll be able to "immerse yourself in the glitz and glam of Hollywood's Golden Age." As you enjoy your food, characters like Mickey Mouse, Minnie Mouse, Donald Duck, and Daisy Duck will make live appearances.

Another restaurant is the **Navigator's Club**. This spot is meant to evoke the "Golden Age of cruising" and the "maritime tradition of dining at the 'Captain's Table.'" Here, you'll get to see Mickey and friends, and they'll share "lively songs and tales of adventure."

Another spot in the rotational dining is **Animator's Palate** (a version of which we've seen on other Disney Cruise Line ships, too). The restaurant celebrates Disney and Pixar animation. You'll eat while surrounded by film strips, director's chairs, animation boards, and more. Plus, you'll get to see your own drawings come to life before your eyes!

**Animator's Table** is a similarly themed space. This is meant to be an "intimate gallery inspired by the classic ink and paint studios of Disney and Pixar animators." As you dine near paint jars and authentic artwork from Disney films, you'll also see your own sketches come to life.





### ENCHANTED SUMMER RESTAURANT

Fans of *Tangled* and *Frozen* will NOT want to miss out on this restaurant!

Here, there are 2 distinct dining rooms inspired by the hit films.

In the Maximus dining room, you'll be "immersed in the atmosphere of a lantern festival – complete with a maypole and hand-painted motifs of the sun and Rapunzel's frying pan." You'll also find equestrian details honoring Maximus!

In the Olaf dining room, you get to "experience the magic of summer solstice in Arendelle." You'll find "a shimmering snowflake chandelier" and other details here.

In both rooms, you'll get to enjoy a seated dinner with a menu of regional and international options. Plus, you can enjoy breakfast and lunch buffets here during the day.

## RESTAURANTS: CASUAL DINING



### PIXAR MARKET RESTAURANT

For more casual and quick eats, you can head to Pixar Market Restaurant. While here, look for nods to movies like *Inside Out*, *Cars*, *Finding Nemo*, *Monsters University*, and more. It's meant to be a casual marketplace that “celebrates the imaginative spirit behind Pixar.” Breakfast and lunch will feature a variety of buffet stations an array of buffet stations. For dinner, the restaurant will offer a seated meal.



### GRAMMA TALA'S KITCHEN

Gramma Tala's Kitchen will be an inviting Quick Service restaurant inspired by the vibrant scenery and island flair of *Moana*. The imaginative menu will showcase the diverse flavors found throughout the Pacific and Asia.

### MOWGLI'S EATERY

Mowgli's Eatery (which is inspired by early concept art from *The Jungle Book*) will serve Indian and regionally inspired cuisine, including vegetarian dishes.

### STITCH'S OHANA GRILL

This quick dining spot (inspired by *Lilo & Stitch*) will feature American eats like burgers and sandwiches (with a “splash of island flair”). It's a beachy space themed with surfboards and more.



### WAYFINDER BAR

For a refreshing drink, go to the shaded Wayfinder Bar in Wayfinder Bay.

### TIANA'S BAYOU LOUNGE

This lounge (inspired by *The Princess and the Frog*) will have specialty coffees, teas, mocktails, beignets, and more!

## RESTAURANTS: CASUAL DINING



### COSMIC KEBABS

This Quick Service spot will honor Ms. Marvel (a.k.a. Kamala Khan, the first Muslim-American Super Hero in the Marvel Universe). Here, you'll find items like kebabs, pitas, tabbouleh, and baba ghanoush. The space is meant to look like a New York-style loft and it'll feature art and memorabilia celebrating the Avengers!



### PIZZA PLANET

This spot is “modeled after the iconic pizza arcade in the *Toy Story* animated films by Pixar.” It'll be a “casual outdoor eatery” with pizza options for you to enjoy.

### WHEEZY'S FREEZIES

If it's soft-serve ice cream you're after, stop by Wheezy's Freezies (inspired by *Toy Story 2*). This spot, which is located by the pool, will feature smoothies in addition to the soft-serve ice cream.

### BEWITCHING BOBA AND BREWS

This spot will offer bubble teas and other delicious drinks inspired by the sea witch, Ursula (and other Disney villains)! Look for neon lights and pop art here.

### PALO CAFE

This will be a walkup coffee bar with coffee, espresso drinks, other drinks, and light bites.

### TAVERNA PORTOROSSO

This “breezy sports bar” is inspired by the Italian village from *Luca*.



## RESTAURANTS: PREMIUM DINING



If you want to take your dining to the next level, you may want to consider some of the premium dining options (which come at an additional fee) on the Disney Adventure.

### MIKE & SULLEY'S – FLAVORS OF ASIA

Mike & Sulley's – Flavors of Asia will feature “four distinct experiences,” including a full-service Japanese steakhouse, a teppanyaki room, a bar with Omakase-style dining, and outdoor dining where you can enjoy sushi and sashimi. It's all inspired by the “Japanese-style eatery in the Pixar animation *Monsters, Inc.*”



### PALO TRATTORIA

Palo Trattoria will be an adult-exclusive restaurant (guests 18 and older), serving Northern Italian cuisine. On the menu, you may find things like “antipasti, pasta and pizzas—plus, succulent seafood and steaks.” This spot is influenced by the dream sequence from *Luca* and will feature “twinkling constellations, moonlit accents and astronomy-inspired décor.”

# ENTERTAINMENT



New stage shows, signature events, and films, plus private karaoke rooms, game shows, and more will be offered on the Disney Adventure!

The all-new stage show **“Remember”** will debut at the Walt Disney Theater aboard the ship. The show stars WALL-E and Eve and will feature other characters from movies like *Coco*, *The Little Mermaid*, *Aladdin*, and other classic Disney and Pixar movies. The show will take you through an unexpected reboot of Eve, and WALL-E will have to restore her memories “through the power of music, hope, and treasured remembrances.”



Avengers fans won't want to miss out on **Avengers Assemble!** This stage spectacular will be held at the Garden Stage in Disney Imagination Garden. You'll get to see all kinds of stunts and special effects that'll highlight the powers of Spider-Man, Iron Man, Captain America, Black Widow, Thor, Black Panther and other characters from the Marvel Cinematic Universe. There will even be “a hilarious appearance by the charismatic “merc with a mouth,” Deadpool himself!”

# ENTERTAINMENT



Another stage show that will be held in the Garden Stage at Disney Imagination Garden is **Duffy and The Friend Ship**. You'll join the characters' guide (Tippy Blu), Duffy, and friends as they "explore the high seas on a heartwarming adventure." There will be songs and more to help you "discover the magic of the ocean, the power of imagination and the true meaning of friendship." PLUS you'll get to meet the characters after the show!



For a swashbuckling adventure, check out **Captain Jack Sparrow & the Siren Queen**. You'll join Captain Jack as he hunts for rare treasure and faces off the Siren Queen (which will be "brought to life on LED screens").



**Moana: Call of the Sea** is a one-of-a-kind musical retelling of the hit *Moana* film. It'll be located in Wayfinder Bay. You'll get to enjoy Moana's story by listening to storytellers and music, and by watching puppetry, water effects, and more.

# ENTERTAINMENT



The **Disney Seas the Adventure** show (also on the *Wish* and *Treasure* ships) features Disney and Pixar characters in a musical adventure filled with Disney tunes.

And for more fun, check out the **Baymax Super Exercise Expo**. This will be held in the Garden Stage in Disney Imagination Garden and will feature Hiro and Baymax from *Big Hero 6*. They'll go through a "high-energy musical exercise routine."

Plus, check out the "**Let's Set Sail**" dance party and "**Mickey's Color Spin Dance Party**."

While on the ship, keep an eye out for character interactions with folks like Mickey and friends, Pixar characters, Marvel heroes and villains, and Disney princesses!



# FAMILY FUN



In terms of water fun, you'll want to stop by Toy Story Place to check out the **Sunnyside Family Pool**, **Woody and Jessie's Wild Slides**, the **Flying Saucer Splash Zone**, the **Toy Story Splash Pad**, and the **whirlpool spas**. Plus, you can watch Disney movies on the 2 jumbo screens.

Adventure seekers will want to check out Marvel Landing to try the 3 NEW attractions at sea – **Groot Galaxy Spin**, **Pym Quantum Racers**, and **Ironcycle Test Run**.

For relaxation, go to Wayfinder Bay, which has a **wading pool**, **massive screen**, and **tiered deck seating**.

There will be a street market called **San Fransokyo Street**, inspired by *Big Hero 6*, where you and your family will find lots of entertainment, including a **“one-of-a-kind family gaming lounge”** called **Big Hero Arcade**. There will be video games and “immersive, high-tech experiences” there.


Inside the Big Hero Arcade, you'll find **Hiro Training Zone** – an “immersive training simulator built by boy genius Hiro Hamada.” It will have groups of four people running, dodging, and blocking their way through a high-tech gaming floor.

# FAMILY FUN



Also inside the Big Hero Arcade, you'll find: **Super Fred Kaiju Chaos** (where you'll "race through on-screen city streets in pursuit of a mysterious foe"), **GoGo Racers** (where you'll "see how long you can last as you move your body to keep in time with an ever-quickening rhythm"), **Honey Lemon Chem-Ball Blast** ("match bubbles to create chemical chain reactions"), and **Wasabi Speed Slice** ("slice and dice obstacles with laser-induced plasma blades").

Plus, you'll get to **meet Baymax** in the San Fransokyo Street area!

Also on San Fransokyo Street, you'll find **Baymax Cinemas**, which will show classic and first-release Disney movies.


Want to go on an adventure around the ship? Check out the **Duffy and Friends Discovery Quest**. You'll follow clues to find lost items around the ship, and you may even be able to win a special prize.

Kiddos can transform into princesses, knights, and sea captains at **Bibbidi Bobbidi Boutique**.

Kiddos can also have a royal tea party over at the **Royal Society for Friendship and Tea**.

And heroes of ALL ages can assemble at **Marvel Style Studio**.





## KID ZONES



There will be spaces for kids only, from six months old to 17 years old.

The “**it’s a small world nursery**” is for little ones 6 months to 3 years of age. Small kiddos can play here while being watched by specially trained counselors, and they may even be visited by Disney friends.

**Disney’s Oceaneer Club** is for kids 3 to 10. Here, kids can play games, participate in storytelling, and more while being guided by Disney youth counselors. The Oceaneer Club will feature a few different areas including **Marvel WEB Workshop** (where kids can test out “prototypes of new suits for Spider-Man and other heroes,” use Avengers tech, and do training simulations), **Andy’s Toybox** (an oversized Toy Story playground with a slide and more), **Fairytale Hall** (where Princesses will come to visit and kids can play games, do arts and crafts, and more), and **Walt Disney Imagineering Lab** (where kids can design a roller coaster and virtually experience their ride).





## KID ZONES



**Mickey & Minnie Captain's Deck** is designed for little cruisers. It's a nautical play area that lets kids sit behind a captain's wheel, go down a slide, climb, play sensory games, and even hang out with Captain Mickey and Minnie (when they stop by to visit!).

The **Royal Society for Friendship and Tea** is an experience for those ages 3-12. Kiddos will be joined by their parents and will get to enjoy treats, listen to stories and songs, and even get a take-home gift. This will require a separate admission that's subject to availability.



**Edge is for tweens ages 11 to 14.** The spot is "disguised as a shop on San Fransokyo Street." But once you head inside, it is meant to look as if "tweens had taken over and redecorated a Victorian-style café." You'll find selfie spots and places to watch movies, play board games, play video games, and more.

**Vibe is for teens 14 to 17.** It will also be disguised from the outside as a shop in San Fransokyo Street. This space has a retro design inspired by a vintage record store. Teens will get to watch movies, play games, and more.



## ADULT OFFERINGS



Adults can pamper themselves at the **spa** (which will include an “expansive Rainforest Room”), take **cycling and yoga classes**, check out the **juice bar**, get a **wellness consultation**, go to the **meditation room**, and enjoy the rest of the **fitness center**.

**Buccaneer Bar** will be one of the adult-only spaces. It is inspired by Captain Hook from *Peter Pan*. There will be a main bar along with 2 private “Captain’s Quarters” banquettes. The bar will serve high-end brews and feature TVs for live sports broadcasts.



Another adult-only space is **Spellbound**, inspired by the Evil Queen from *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs*. It’ll be in Town Square and will feature various cocktails!

Plus, **Marvel Style Studio** will transform into an adults-only lounge at night with exclusive drink options.

# STATEROOMS

The Disney Adventure will offer a variety of staterooms with details you won't find anywhere else - including art that's inspired by Disney, Pixar, and Marvel. Many feature Disney's split concept bathroom design.

There are 4 main room categories - **Inside**, **Oceanview**, **Verandah**, and **Concierge**.

Inside staterooms will sleep up to 4. Some inside staterooms will be a Deluxe category with **views of Disney Discovery Reef**.

Oceanview staterooms sleep up to 4 and feature ocean views from a large window.

Verandah staterooms sleep up to 4 and have different view options, including a view of the ocean, a view of Disney Imagination Garden, or a view of Disney Discovery Reef.

In the Concierge category, you'll find a variety of options, including rooms with views of the ocean or Disney Imagination Garden. There are also some staterooms overlooking Wayfinder Bay. The rooms are themed to *Frozen*, *Aladdin*, *Thor*, and *The Little Mermaid*. And *Moana* fans can check out the "special selection of staterooms overlooking the open oasis of Wayfinder Bay."

## ROYAL SUITES


Within the Concierge category, there are Royal Suites! These are themed to *Frozen*. There is an Elsa Royal Suite and an Anna Royal Suite.

Both feature themed artwork, a dining area with a bar, a large bedroom, and a kids' room with bunk beds. Plus, you'll find 2 bathrooms, an extended verandah (with its own private whirlpool!), and MORE!

Royal Suites can sleep up to 6 and generally feature:


- 2 main bedrooms
